Ingredients

90g Flour
50g Sugar
60225g Butter/Margarine
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons Baking Powder
 $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon Salt
 $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon Almond Extract
1 small Egg
About $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of green sugar crystals

Method

1. into a large bowl, put in the flour, sugar butter, baking powder, salt, almond extract and egg. Beat the ingredients until well blended.
2. Put half a handful to the side, and refrigerate.
3. With remaining dough, roll into sausage shape. Then into a triangle shape, by pinching the sides.
4. Refrigerate for 2 hours.
5. Preheat oven to 180 (gas mark 5) and slice logs into 'Tree' shape. Then, with reserved dough, put the base of the tree on.
6. Bake the cookies for 10 – 12 minutes. Then cool for 5 minutes before eating!
